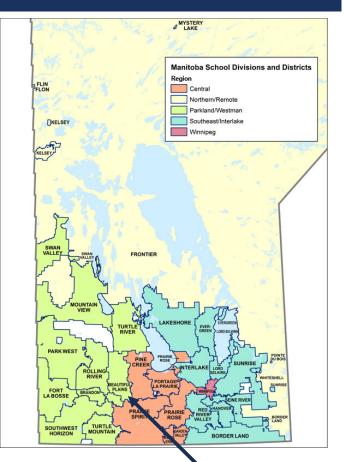

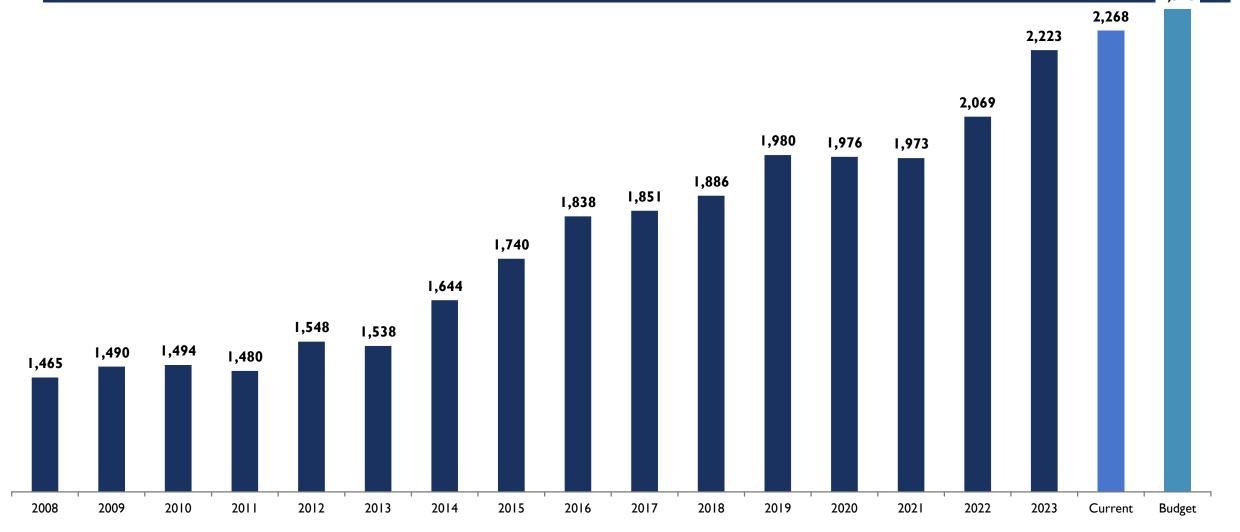

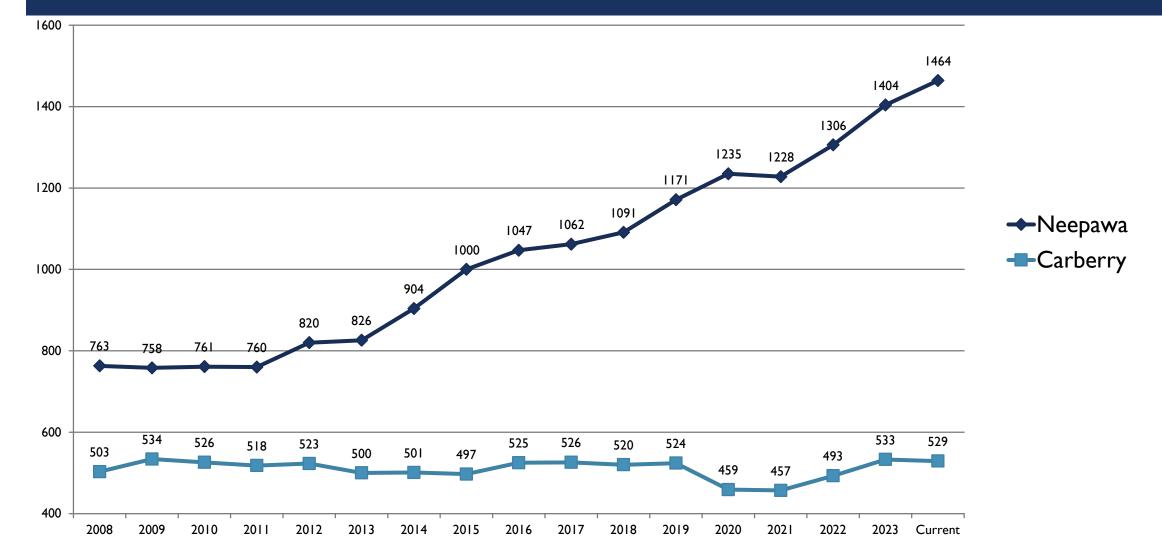


ENROLMENT HISTORY

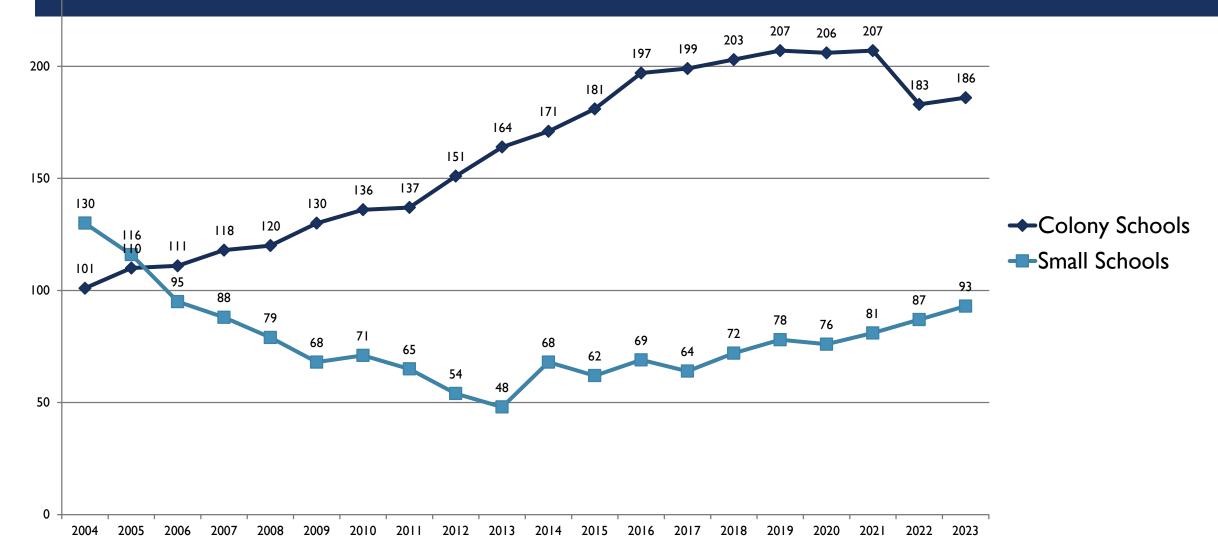




ENROLMENT – LARGE SCHOOLS



ENROLMENT – SMALL SCHOOLS



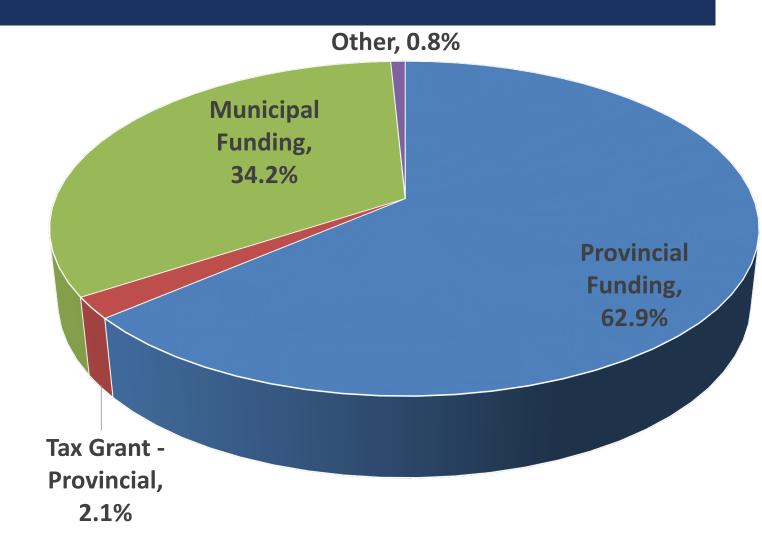
REVENUE SOURCES

Provincial Revenue

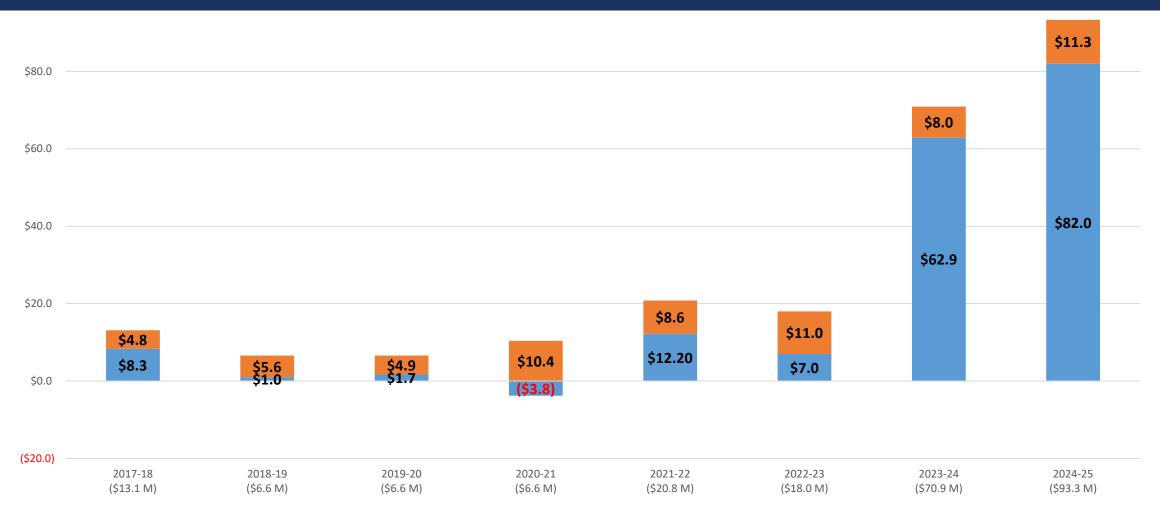
- Majority of our revenue at 62.9%
- Enrolment levels affect this revenue
- Property Tax Offset Grant
 - Funding to allow divisions to maintain taxation/special levy at 2020 level

Municipal Revenue

- Tax levies restricted beginning in 2019
- Phase out of property taxes began in 2021
- Other Revenue
 - Tuition fees from students attending from outside the division

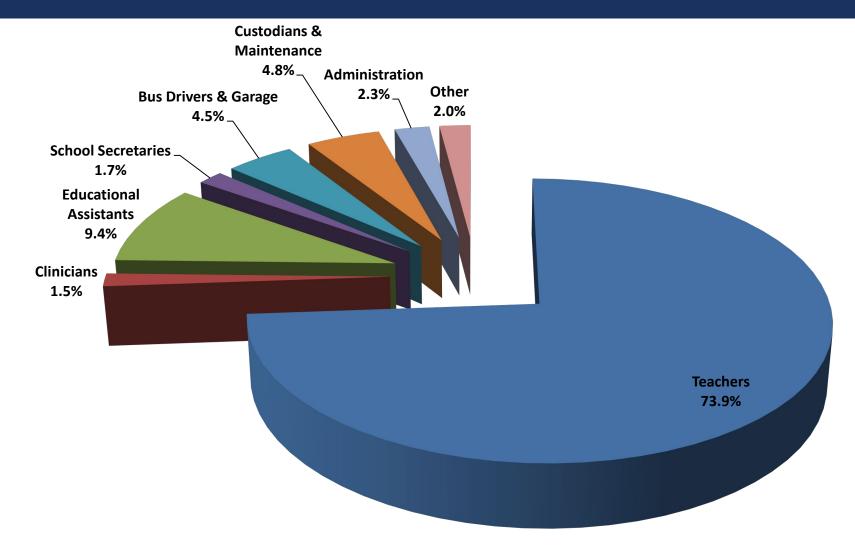

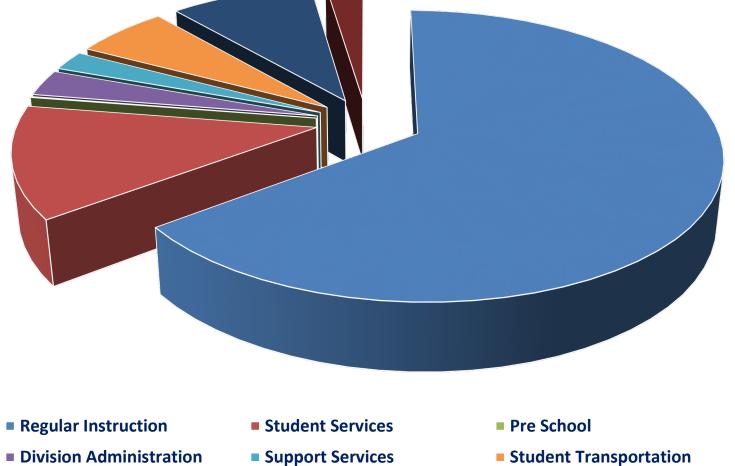
