## **IN-CAMERA SESSIONS - COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE**

The Board may meet "in-camera" as a committee for any of the following purposes:

- 1. To discuss matters of collective negotiation with employees or their representatives.
- 2. To discuss matters pertaining to salaries or fringe benefits or any Division employee.
- 3. To consider information regarding appointment, employment, or dismissal of an employee.
- 4. To discuss the acquisition of real property.
- 5. To discuss litigation or potential litigation against the Division.
- 6. To consider student disciplinary cases.
- 7. To consider appointment of a member to fill a vacancy on the Board.
- 8. To take any other action where the statutes or regulations allow or require a closed section.

Whenever an in-camera session is held the Board shall meet in open or regular session to take final action.

In-camera sessions of the Board are strictly confidential and information discussed in these sessions must not be made public other than by the consent and/or direction or the Board as a corporate body.
