

ADMINISTRATIVE GOALS

The goal of the Division Administration is to help create and foster an environment in which pupils can learn most effectively. Administrative duties and functions should be appraised in terms of the contribution that is made to better instruction and more effective learning, which will result in the development of worthwhile citizens who have the ability to think and who are capable of using their abilities wisely.

The Division Administration must accept much of the responsibility for the success or failure of the organization. It is their responsibility, under the direction of the School Board, to mobilize and co-ordinate all available resources in the development of an educational program designed to stimulate the best effort in each pupil. The major responsibilities would include:

- selecting teachers who will help pupils discover and develop abilities which might otherwise remain dormant.
- maintaining the school facilities and transportation systems with modifications made where necessary to better meet our educational goal.
- providing secretarial and other staff to support the educational goals.
- acquiring supplies and equipment necessary for the operation of the schools.
