SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION BUDGETS

The Board recognizes that the schools of the Division require transportation for curricular and extra-curricular activities and hereby authorizes the establishment of an annual transportation budget for each of the schools in the Division.

Once established this budget may be expended in either of the following ways:

- 1. By using Division owned buses which will be charged to them at a specific rate per mile for miles travelled and a specific hourly rate for the driver's time. Both the rate per mile and the driver's hourly wage shall be as established by the Board.
- 2. By hiring private vehicles that will be paid a mileage rate as established between the **school** and the vehicle owner. For insurance purposes all private vehicles used to transport students must be authorized by the school administration. Although the Board discourages the use of private vehicles for curricular or extracurricular activities, use is permitted on a limited basis.

The transportation costs for the following activities will be assumed by the Division and not charged to school budgets.

- 1. Participation in the Carberry and Neepawa Fine Arts Festivals.
- 2. Participation in the Provincial final of any sporting activity recognized by the Manitoba High Schools Athletic Association.
- 3. Participation in the Provincial final of any school activity authorized by the Board.
