

STAFF CONDUCT

The responsibility for acceptable conduct, dress and language rests primarily with the employee as a responsible and professional individual.

The Division expects all employees to adhere to a standard of personal conduct, dress and language in the school buildings, on the school grounds, at school activities outside of the school, and whenever they are discharging their responsibilities to the Division, which is above reproach and which contributes to a high morale in the school and a wholesome school reputation.

The administrative superior may require acceptable conduct and/or dress on the part of the employee. Administrators should report recurring instances of improper conduct and/or dress to the Board for further action.
