The goal for Physical Education/Health Curriculum in Beautiful Plains School Division is to provide students with planned and balanced programming to develop skills and attitudes for physically active and healthy lifestyles for all students. Potentially sensitive outcomes identified by Manitoba Education are treated in ways that are appropriate for local school and community context.

Parental Involvement

As part of the planning process for potentially sensitive outcomes (PSO's), schools are required to inform parents of the content areas involving PSO's. Parents are offered an alternative option for delivery of PSO's which include:

- home delivery
- alternative delivery
- opt out option

If the school based program delivery is rejected by the parent, it will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to instruct his/her child based on the MB Health curriculum.
