

STUDENT PLACEMENT

The following general guidelines will be in effect for all students transferring into the Beautiful plains School Division from other educational jurisdictions.

1. Students from outside of Canada

The receiving school with assistance from Manitoba Education will assess the student records, and will supplement this information with assessments and testing conducted by school personnel. Final placement will be made by the school after consultation with the parents.

2. Students from outside Manitoba but within Canada

(a) Students from public schools that have a recognized curriculum will be placed according to the student records that are provided. Placement adjustments may be made on the basis of assessments and testing conducted by the receiving school.

(b) Students from private schools or home-study will be placed according to assessments and testing conducted by the receiving school.

In both (a) and (b) the placement will be made after consultation with the parents.

3. Students from within Manitoba

(a) Students from public or private schools that subscribe to the Manitoba curriculum, or students having completed correspondence courses, will be placed according to the student records provided by the previous educational jurisdiction.

(b) Students from private schools that do not follow the Manitoba curriculum, and students from home schooling (other than correspondence courses) will be placed according to assessments and testing conducted by the receiving school.

In both (a) and (b) above the placement will be made after consultation with the parents.

4. Appeals

Parents have the right to appeal to the Board of Trustees a student placement made by a Division School. Such appeal should be made in writing within thirty days of the placement. The parents will be afforded a hearing before the Board. The decision of the Board of Trustees regarding the appeal will be final.
