

STUDENT EXPULSION

The Division Board has the authority to expel any student from the schools of the Division for conduct detrimental to the normal functioning of the school. An out of school suspension lasting longer than six weeks shall be considered an expulsion.

Expulsion should come only as a last resort, and after consultation with the parents or legal guardians of the student concerned. Board members should have been made aware of the seriousness of the student's conduct before receiving a recommendation for expulsion by a report by the Superintendent/CEO on the conduct of the student concerned.

A recommendation for expulsion may be made to the Board by the Superintendent/CEO-
